

All in One Module 12s (Mobiles)



Important - Read these instructions before using this equipment;

This equipment must only be used by competent persons. Not to be used by minors. Anyone with a temporary or permanent disability should seek expert advice before using.

These safety guidelines are intended as a guide for experienced operators. Detailed Operation Instructions relative to a specific make/model or equipment area available upon request from your nearest depot.

Do not use equipment whilst under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Seek medical advice if using prescribed medication before using.

Always ensure correct personal protective clothing is worn when using this equipment. As an absolute minimum, you should wear the equipment recommended above.

Ensure the work area is clear and safe and that no-one is nearby or could distract you.

Before starting equipment, ensure all controls are understood, in particular the stop procedure.

After use, store the equipment safely and securely away from minors.

Daily Checks

The operator should carry out the following daily checks before operating this machine;

Tyres: Splits, cuts, pressures (96psi), tread.

Wheel Nuts: Tightness.

Brakes: Function.

Tow Hitch: Security, damage.

Lights: Function, damage.

Fluid Levels: Check prior to use and thereafter every four hours..

Re-fuelling: Take care when re-fuelling. Wipe up any spilt fuel. *Never* refuel whilst the engine is running. *Do not* smoke whilst re-fuelling.

Carbon Monoxide Monitor: The unit should be fitted with a carbon monoxide detector. Test monitor daily.

Operation

These units are not designed for sleeping in. Ensure adequate ventilation at all times.

Ensure that the vehicle's towing capacity is sufficient to tow the unit safely.

These units are not designed to carry goods.

These units are not designed to be towed above 50MPH.

Do not exceed the capacity of the trailer.

Check the tow bar and coupling.

Connect to towing vehicle ensuring that the breakaway cable is connected.

Connect lighting cable to towing vehicle, check correct operation of all lights.

Raise the jockey wheel fully and lock. Release the handbrake.

Important. When the generator is **not** running ensure that the on/off switch is in the off position.

Do not use additional electrical equipment that may overload the generator.

Care must be taken when opening and closing doors in windy conditions to prevent limbs being trapped in doors.

It is a criminal offence to smoke or allow smoking in these units.

If any fault arises do not operate the machine or try to rectify the fault. Contact your nearest depot for assistance.
