

All in One Module 26

Important - Read these instructions before using this equipment;

This equipment must only be used by competent persons. Not to be used by minors. Anyone with a temporary or permanent disability should seek expert advice before using.

These safety guidelines are intended as a guide for experienced operators. Detailed Operation Instructions relative to a specific make/model or equipment area available upon request from your nearest depot.

Do not use equipment whilst under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Seek medical advice if using prescribed medication before using.

Always ensure correct personal protective clothing is worn when using this equipment. As an absolute minimum, you should wear the equipment recommended above.

Do not use equipment indoors or in poorly ventilated areas.

Ensure the work area is clear and safe and that no-one is nearby or could distract you.

Before starting equipment, ensure all controls are understood, in particular the stop procedure.

After use, store the equipment safely and securely away from minors.

Daily Checks

The operator should carry out the following daily checks before operating this machine;

Fluid Levels: Check prior to use and thereafter every four hours.

Safety Guards: In place and secure.

Safety Decals: In place and clear.

Re-fuelling: Take care when re-fuelling. Use diesel fuel only. Wipe up any spilt fuel. *Never* refuel whilst the engine is running. *Do not* smoke whilst re-fuelling.

Operation

Generator

All connections should be made by a competent person.

Use the correct plugs and correctly rated cable to make connections.

Do not overload the machine. Consult the nearest depot if in any doubt regarding capacity.

Do not use the machine with loose or missing components or guards.

When doing any work on the generator ensure that the emergency stop button is engaged to prevent remote starting of the engine.

General

The site for the unit should be firm and level.

When using jacklegs ensure locking pins are fully engaged.

If the unit needs to be chocked up to make it level, use only wooden or metal chocks. Never use bricks or building blocks as these can crumble and cause instability.

Care must be taken when opening and closing doors in windy conditions to prevent limbs being trapped in doors.

It is a criminal offence to smoke or allow smoking in these units.

If any fault arises do not operate the machine or try to rectify the fault. Contact your nearest depot for assistance.
